Before the competition:

- Your eye protection
- Your hearing protection
- Stopwatch
- Targets (ISSF 25/50m Precision)
- Patches
- Score sheets (Registers) – record calibre and Class F (Frontier) or Class O (Open)
- Be familiar with the operation of the timer

Preparation and sighting series:

Check the range is clear of personnel: 5 minutes before the competition time, call ...

“PREPARATION TIME BEGINS NOW”

- Start stopwatch
- (for competition) check shooters in correct bays, pistols approved, Start Numbers (if provided)

After 5 (five) minutes, stop stopwatch, call ...

“SIGHTING SERIES ... LOAD”

After 1 minute, call ...

“ATTENTION” and activate the targets (or **“START”** for stationary targets).

After 6 (six) minutes (end of shooting and cleaning), call ...

“STOP ... UNLOAD”

- Clear all pistols
- Allow scoring personnel forward, targets scored at the target line, score bullet holes 50% across line

Competition series:

After all personnel have returned from scoring, call ...

“FIRST (second, third, fourth) SERIES... LOAD”

After 1 minute, call ...

“ATTENTION” and activate the targets (or **“START”** for stationary targets).

After 6 (six) minutes (end of shooting and cleaning), call ...

“STOP ... UNLOAD”

- Clear all pistols
- Allow scoring personnel forward, targets scored at the target line, score bullet holes 50% across line

At the end of the relay and all personnel have returned:

- Clear all pistols for casing and removal
- Complete Range Report, and forward to Classification Office

Sighting Series Malfunctions – complete on stationary facing target in 60 seconds (III.4(b)).

Allowable Malfunctions – reload 5 rounds, repeat the series, credit 5 lowest value shots (III.4(f)).

Only ONE Allowable Malfunction permitted per Stage (III.4(h)).

Non-Allowable Malfunctions – score ONLY the shots on target (III.4(g)).
